ATTENTION RIDERS: On July 1st, all RTA bus routes on former designated systems will be assigned NEW, 3-digit route numbers as shown below. To identify your bus, locate your former route name and the corresponding 3-digit number. Bus header signs and timetable schedules will display the name shown on the right to eliminate rider confusion as we transition to the new system.

100's – Reserved for the City of Annapolis- Annapolis Transit Routes;

200's – Anne Arundel County- Former Connect-A-Ride routes;

On July 1st, all RTA bus routes on former designated systems from Anne Arundel and Howard Counties, northern Prince George's, and the City of Laurel will be assigned new, 3-digit numbers. To avert customer confusion, buses will display both the old and new route names. For instance, the bus header sign and new timetable schedules for the riders of the Howard Transit Orange Route will read "Route 404/Orange."
