1. Approval of November 12, 2020 meeting minutes

The November 12, 2020 meeting minutes were approved without requiring any edits.

2. RTA Announcements

- COVID-19 response updates
 - RTA is still disinfecting all vehicles and facilities nightly with hospital-grade disinfectant in response to the COVID-19 outbreak, following all local and state guidelines for mask usage, etc.
- Reintroduction of fares, for both bus and Mobility service, occurred for January 2nd, 2021
 - This included the originally planned GPT Mobility fare increase, which would have taken place back in October if we had been charging fares then
- RTA Leadership news
- November 1st service updates
 - Jason informed the group that Cristin Tolen has left RTA for a regional VP role with First Transit
 - o Jason has left his position at Howard County and is RTA's new General Manager
 - o Sue Poole is no longer Director of Marketing and Communication
 - o Currently hiring a new safey/training lead, other positions within the agency

- Mobile Ticketing Launch
 - Going great soft launched in February and have, to date, had 71 unique people purchase tickets
 - o Active marketing, student sign-up features, and more launching next month (March)
 - o Go on Transit App and try it out when you get a chance

3. RAC Announcements

- Applications will be sent out as usual with this set of minutes
- Looking in to getting future dates posted in all vehicles but as always, these meetings take place the second Thursday evening of every February, May, August, and November.

4. Public Comment

- Chris shared a technical snafoo where a Zoom meeting join code did not match up to tonight's meeting RTA will look in to the posting in question
- Astamay inquired about the Ellicott City service changes that were mentioned last meeting
 - Bruce responded that Howard County is having ongoing budget discussions and currently determining project feasibility
 - Jason advised that the specific ideas are to transition the current 405 to an Ellicott Cityfocused circulator with no service to Columbia, and add a new route 505 that connects Columbia, Ellicott City and Catonsville, MD (in a routing that resembles the current 405 that operates Mon-Sat evenings and Sundays)
 - To accommodate new expansions in to Catonsville, more conversations need to be had and 402B and 407 extra weekday service would not be introduced back when other service gets reinstated
 - o This service would connect directly in Catonsville with MTA core bus service
 - Public hearings and lots of outreach will need to happen for RTA and Howard County to pursue these service changes, so much more to come
- Kristen shared that 401 peak hour service are getting crowded
 - o RTA will look in to this and current tripper (additional services) policy and protocol
- Astamay asked about the Ellicott City Walmart stop
 - o Jason advised that no final determinations have been made yet, but that RTA is still evaluating all options
 - We stillprefer the stop being away from the high-traffic area with lots of carts and pedestrians, and that a county road with county right-of-way makes it possible to add a trash can, bench, and other amenities to the stop
- Astamay asked about the point reaised last meeting that changes be made to Mobility service drop-off policy
 - Jason advised that no further conversations have been had on that subject, due to difficulties presented in regard to how Mobility services must compare to fixed-route services available to the public
